


MACHINE WASH GUIDE

PRE-TREAT

Lightly soiled = pre treat with **LAUNDRY BAR** or **STAIN REMOVER SPRAY** (Test in small area first)



OR

SOAK IF HEAVILY SOILED



FABRIC BRIGHTENER (1L for every 10L) for 12 hrs
OXYBOOST



- Long soak (overnight) **60g** for every **10L** of warm water or
- Quick soak, **75g** for every **5L** of warm water, for at least 30 mins-2 hours.


1. ADD SOAP

(Medium Load 6-10kg)

Add **LAUNDRY POWDER (30g or 1 scoop)** or **LAUNDRY LIQUID (30ml or 2 caps)**




MACHINE TIME




2. SOFTEN

Add **FABRIC SOFTENER TO TRAY (120ml)**




3. BOOST

OXYBOOST (30g or 1 scoop) or **FABRIC BRIGHTENER (60ml)** INTO PRE-WASH TRAY or DIRECTLY TO DRUM




4. START MACHINE



Pour powder directly into drum if powder gets stuck in the tray.

DOSING

5. DRY & FRESHEN



Air Dry and use **FRESHENING SPRAY** for light fragrance

MACHINE LOAD	LAUNDRY POWDER	LAUNDRY LIQUID	SOFTENER	FABRIC BRIGHTENER	OXYBOOST
6 - 10kg	30g	30ml	120ml	60ml	30g
10 - 15kg	60g	60ml	240ml	120ml	60g
16+kg	90g	90ml	480ml	240ml	90g

GENERAL

Fabric Brightener - Use gloves if you are submerging hands doing hand wash or pre-soaking

OxyBoost - activated with warm water. Either use warm water to dilute / activate, or do whole soak in warm water.

Laundry Liquid, Laundry Powder, Fabric Brightener, Stain Remover & OxyBoost - Don't use on wool, cashmere, silk - use sensitive skin laundry powder or pure soap.

Dosing tools > If using Jerrycans to measure - this is the reference. Fabric Softener and Brightener come in 1L jerrycans or 5L.

- 1L jerrycan cap = 7.5ml (4 caps = 30ml)
- 5L jerrycan cap = 15ml (2 caps = 30ml)
- Laundry Liquid - the cap for the 3L jerrycan is 15ml each, so 2 caps = 30mls for average load sizes.

30ml Scoop is provided inside of all Laundry Powders, and OxyBoost packaging.

TIPS

- Do maintenance on your machine every 6 months
- Clean inner rubber parts of machine door regularly
- Separate colors & whites to prevent bleeding
- Treat stains as early as possible
